### **KIT LIST**

**Note:** Clothing displaying profanity, racial, offensive or sexist remarks will not be permitted. Revealing or questionable clothing is not acceptable to be worn at our Rally. Interpretation of such materials will be at the discretion of Rally Administration. Sleeveless shirts or open toed shoes may not be worn.

- 2 pair of running shoes
- at least 4 pair of socks
- at least 4 pair of underwear
- pajamas and a bath robe
- 2 pairs of jeans or casual pants
- 3 pairs of shorts
- at least 4 shirts or T-shirts [observe note above – no white and no tank tops!]
- sun screen
- Raincoat, rain hat, boots
- warm (light) sweater or a jacket
- Towel and face cloth
- Toilet articles [brush/comb, soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, shampoo, tissue]
- insect repellent
- flashlight
- Triangular bandage
- Refillable water bottle – dishwasher safe
- Garden gloves or similar for Treetop Trekking
- camera [optional] – we will have a place for downloading pictures
- Summer Dress SJA Uniform for our traditional Rally closing ceremonies.  
Uniform shirt, tie, black pants, black shoes and black socks.
- Bedding – pillow, sleeping bag**

**IF YOU ARE 15 YEARS OLD OR OLDER YOU WILL BE SLEEPING OUTDOORS!!! IF YOU INDICATED YOU CAN BRING A TENT PLEASE DO SO!!!. EVEN IF YOU ARE NOT BRINGING A TENT YOU NEED TO BRING A SLEEPING PAD/MATTRESS.**

#### **Notes**

- Mark everything with the participant's name: First and Last names
- MP3, iPods and other electronic equipment are not recommended and will only be permitted during designated free time periods and should be clearly labeled with participant's name: First and Last names.
- In a large camp, security of one's personal possessions is always a concern. It is therefore recommended that participants do not bring valuables to camp.
- We will be outdoors rain or shine so be prepared.
- The above items are considered minimal and failure to bring some items may restrict full participation in some parts of the program.

## GENERAL CAMP RULES

1. All members (including Officers) shall submit a signed copy of the appropriate Agreement/Permission form indicating that they have read and agree to the rules, and in the case of members under 18 years of age, have parental/guardian permission to be at this event. Registration payment is required from all leaders and participants.
2. All youth members shall submit a properly completed and accurate Medical Information Form prior to the event. This form shall be signed by the member if 18 years of age or older, and by the parent(s) / guardian(s) otherwise. The Camp Medical Officer shall hold the form. The form shall be kept in confidence at all times. Disclosure of all pertinent medical conditions and treatments is required to ensure the safety of all of our participants.
3. For the purposes of these General Camp Rules, the phrase “Officer(s)-in-Charge” refer to the Rally Committee Chair.
4. Any sickness or accident must be reported to the Medical Officer and leaders/Officer(s)-in-Charge. All members are encouraged to use our Medical Services, should medications require refrigeration or the member require supervision with their medication usage.
5. Appropriate standards of behavior for a youth rally are expected by all participants throughout the rally.
6. For the security of our participants a wrist ban policy will be used. Rally wrist bands shall be worn at all times and will identify our participants.
7. While under the care and guardianship of the Officer(s)-in-Charge of this rally, all participants will respect the law and the implications and rules that must be observed.
  - a. The Tobacco Control Act of Ontario was passed in 1994 and prohibits smoking in many public places, including schools and on school property; as well, prohibits selling or supplying of tobacco products to anyone under 19 years of age; guardians and parents are not exempted from this law.
  - b. In light of our location and our concerns, smoking will only be permitted in designated outdoor common area.
  - c. Any use or possession of illicit drugs or medications which are deemed to not be for documented medical use purposes by the participant in question will face immediate removal from the camp.
  - d. There shall be no alcohol consumed by any participant of this Rally over the duration of the event.
8. While at camp, only the designated members assigned to a residence bedroom or tent will be permitted to be in the designed bedroom/tent. All social gatherings will be held in designated common areas and NOT within anyone’s residence bedroom/tent.
9. The Rally Administration may implement additional rules as required for the safety and well-being of the participants and for the success of Rally.
10. All activities will be properly supervised. Members under 18 years of age shall be supervised by the leaders/Officer(s)-in-Charge of the event. Members who fail to conduct themselves in an acceptable manner, or by action or inaction endanger themselves or others, the Rally Administration may return the member to their parent(s) or guardian(s), at the parent(s) or guardian(s) expense.

Members 18 years of age or older shall remain with/at the event unless given permission to leave by the Officer(s)-in-Charge. Members who fail to conduct themselves in an acceptable manner, or by action or inaction endanger themselves or others, the Rally Administration shall require the member to leave under his/her own supervision and expense. All members 18 years of age or older who register to participate at our event will be expected to participate with our activities as assigned.
