Entering the trailer approximately 15-20 feet, they discover two youths who are stuck inside (a cage, a transport truck trailer, something enclosed and inaccessible by the first aider.)

One Casualty is alert and the other is unconscious.

Signs of shock - SWEATING; PALE; ANXIETY

ABRASIONS right side of face

LACERATION across lower right leg

Casualty TWO

Signs of shock - SWEATING; PALE;

CYANOTIC - NON Breathing, Obstructed Airway (Gum)

ABRASIONS to left side of face after falling

Suspected FRACTURE left ankle

P1 should be concerned with P2 if P2 is ever being ignored by team member.
