History

Having been running with the class, this patient has entered "Insulin Shock" due to the excess activity. Staggering up the stairs, he has fallen onto the stairs hitting his left knee and hitting his nose with his arm has he landed on the stairs.

Patient to be found lying on the stairs (about 2-3 stairs higher than the landing) lying back with his back and head against the stairs. Blood should be found in mouth.
