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INJURIES

- Fractured right Tibia/Fibula (open Tibia fracture)
- Fractured right Clavicle (same side; closed)
- Fractured right Humerus (same side; closed)
- Fractured jaw with bleeding from split lip lots of blood around the face but nothing from ears.
- Frothy blood in mouth blood capsules.
- Person is unconscious throughout scenario.

CASUALTY PROMPTS

While setting up for the Annual dinner, one volunteer fell from a ladder sustaining multiple injuries.

- Fractured right Tibia/Fibula (open Tibia fracture)
- Fractured right Clavicle (same side; closed)
- Fractured right Humerus (same side; closed)
- Fractured jaw with bleeding from split lip lots of blood around the face but nothing from ears.
- Frothy blood in mouth blood capsules.
- Person is unconscious throughout scenario but responds to pain.
- Person is unconscious but the competitor will have to tell them to breath through the nose.

PROPS

- Moulage for fractured humerus.
- Moulage for fractured clavicle.
- Moulage for fractured tibia.
- Dental cotton wad for fractured jaw.
- Blood capsule for bleeding from the mouth.
