JUDGE'S COPY OF SCENARIO INDIVIDUAL SCENARIO

You are attending the opening of a new Community Centre. During the tour of the facility you come across a room that is still under construction. You notice a carpet layer on his back in the middle of the room.

There will be an announcement of times after the first 3 minutes and again at the final 2 minutes.

INJURIES

- Stroke (CVA) non verbal
- Paralyzed right side
- Impaled carpet knife in left thigh

CASUALTY PROMPTS

- Conscious
- Casualty unable to talk; able to moan and answer yes/no questions by moaning appropriately
- Casualty is found lying on their back.
- Casualty is not currently on any medications.
- Medical Alert Bracelet (Hypertension) – (left arm)

PROPS

- Casualty is wearing tyvec coveralls
- Impaled carpet knife left thigh; anterior position, perpendicular to thigh, slightly bent to right side
- Medical Alert Bracelet (hypertension) – (left arm)

JUDGES' PROMPTS

- Casualty is conscious but unable to speak
- Casualty is paralyzed right side
- Casualty is pale and sweaty.
- Casualty's skin is cool and clammy throughout scenario.
- Casualty's respirations are 20, irregular and laboured throughout scenario
- Casualty's pulse is 110 regular and weak throughout scenario.
- Casualty's pupils are unequal, left pupil is dilated and non-reactive, right 4 mm and reactive.
- **At two minute final warning, Casualty becomes unconscious**
