Lockers TEAM SCENARIO

Background Scenario

It is November 17th and your team is attending an Occupational Health and Safety Conference at Milliken Mills High School. While your team was waiting to get into the next session, you hear a scream for help.

There will be a 3minute warning to the judges to signify the end of the primary survey.
There will also be a 2minute left signal for the team's benefit.

INJURIES

- Nausea
- Reduced level of consciousness (slightly confused)
- Knife lacerations: ALL BLEEDING
 1. Shallow 5cm (2") to the left side of the neck.(further to the back of the neck NOT the front)
 2. Knife stab wound to the right hand (completely through)
 3. Fractured Left wrist. (base of thumb area)

CASUALTY PROMPTS

- Starts by casualty yelling for help.
- Casualty is found lying on their left side.
- Casualty is a student at the school, forgot something in their locker.
- Casualty is conscious, but slightly confused and breathing throughout scenario
- Casualty did not know the guy who attacked him.
- The guy (assailant) wanted to steal my ipod...I shouldn't have fought back..he pulled a knife, cut me and pushed me the ground, then ran away. He wasn't from this school.
- Casualty is feeling nauseous but has not vomited.
- Casualty has not eaten today
- Casualty has an allergy to ASA.

PROPS

- Casualty is wearing jeans, a T-shirt, and shoes
- First Aid kit #2 (Provided) ; **plus all necessary replacement stock x 4 (including boxes of Gloves in Medium & Large)**
- Picture of a fire alarm for the wall.
- First Aid Station signs
- Clip boards for judges
- Plastic and duct tape to protect the floor
- Patient care records

JUDGES' PROMPTS

- Judge informs team that the area is safe. IF ASKED. The assailant is gone and there is no knife present.
- Casualty does NOT knows the guy. IF ASKED.
- Casualty's respirations are 25, regular and shallow throughout scenario.
- Casualty's pulse is 110 (regular and weak) throughout scenario.
- Casualty is conscious and slightly confused throughout scenario
- Casualty's pupils are equal, 4 mm and reactive.
- Casualty's skin is cool, pale, and clammy throughout scenario.
- Casualty's breath is odorless.
