Team Scenario # 1

You are at the trailer, which has been setup for St. John as a first aid room when all of a sudden one of the race marshals comes running in yelling that they need help. A wheel has come off one of the cars, and bounced up into the stands injuring several people.

INJURIES and SIMULATION

- Spinal injury cervical area lump about the fourth vertebrae
- Shock pale and sweaty
- Bruising to forehead above left eye head hit ground when knocked over by tire
- Injured left knee badly swollen and bruised
- Unconscious throughout
- Beer on casualty's breath
