Team Scenario # 1

While you and your partner were getting your first aid kits from the Divisional cabinet at St. John House for a duty, you hear a yell for help from the caretaker's room down the hall.

Good luck! You have 20 minutes to complete the scenario.

There will be a 5 minute cue and a 2 minutes left warning.

SPECIFIC PATIENT PROMPTS AND CUES FOR TEAMS AND JUDGES:

TIME CUES:

A ***five minute warning*** will be given - this will signify the end of scoring points in the ESM / Primary Survey part of the score sheet.

A ***two minute remaining*** cue will be given to indicate that two minutes of working time remain

A ***problem complete cue will be given at 20 minutes*** from the start of the problem. No additional time is to be allowed for any reason (ie. PCR, etc)

PATIENT PROMPTS:

- Was standing on desk changing a light bulb, slipped and fell striking their head on the corner of the desk

- Knocked out for a minute (Conscious now)

-Allergies: Tylenol and Penicillin

- Medications: ASA 81mg once a day

 : Blood Pressure pill (Not sure of its name)

 : Nitro Spray, takes when needed

NOTE: Does not have any of them with him/her today.

- History of MI (heart attack) in 2001

PATIENT SIMULATION INFORMATION

PROPS:

None

INJURIES:

- Deep 5cm long laceration to right side of forehead.
- Open fracture of left femur just above knee
- Closed fracture of the right wrist at the base of the thumb.

POSITIONING:

- Lying flat on back holding their right wrist.
- Attempt to have patient turn left leg outwards with a slight bend of the knee to give the illusion that the leg has been shortened
