SPECIFIC PATIENT PROMPTS AND CUES FOR TEAMS AND JUDGES:

TIME CUES:

A ***five minute warning*** will be given - this will signify the end of scoring points in the ESM / Primary Survey part of the score sheet.

A ***two minute remaining*** cue will be given to indicate that two minutes of working time remain

A ***problem complete cue will be given at 20 minutes*** from the start of the problem. No additional time is to be allowed for any reason (ie. PCR, etc)

PATIENT PROMPTS:

While you were walking and not watching what you were doing and out of the blue a golf cart ran into me and knocked me over.

-Allergies: Erythromycin

- Medications: Penicillin 300mg 4 times a day for a throat infection.

- Medical history: Mitral Valve Prolapse (MVP), (hearts valve problem)

PATIENT SIMULATION INFORMATION

PROPS:

-None

INJURIES:

- Horizontal 3cm long laceration to **base of right neck** (jugular vein) bleeding freely.
- Embedded piece of glass in **right upper arm** with minor bleeding.
- Closed fracture of the **right** wrist.
- No LOC, but slightly confused

POSITIONING:

- Sitting with left hand full of blood holding right side of neck.
