



3.050 Food Storage



Depending on where you are camping and the time of year, there will be some adjusting on your part.

The following are the basic rules to follow -

1. Store all food in a tight container. A wooden box large enough to hold all dry non-perishables is a good idea. You should be able to lock it. Small animals can open latches, etc.
2. All perishables must be stored in a cooler with plenty of ice. Blocks of ice work best. Replace ice as often as necessary.
3. Remember - Raccoons can use their paws just like a hand. They can even open jars.
4. Be sure all food is safely stored for the night.
