

3.060 Garbage Disposal



Methods of garbage disposal may vary from area to area. Check before you camp to see if there is a regular pick up at the camp site.

The following suggestions may be helpful -

- 1. Keep garbage to a minimum by careful planning.
- 2. If necessary, be prepared to carry out with you any garbage that cannot be burned. Cans should not be buried as they take forever to decay and may injure animals.
- 3. Separate garbage into three bags
 - a) dry, burnable
 - b) wet, tin foil
 - c) recyclables (cans, bottles etc.)

Note: To save space, open cans at both ends, remove the labels which are burnable and then flatten the tins.

Proper handling of garbage at all times will minimise problems from flies and animals.
