



3.081 Coleman Stoves - Preparation



1. Have large wooden matches in a waterproof container and a stone for "striking" or commercial lighter.
2. Have a box of baking soda or fire extinguisher nearby.
3. Open the stove lid and secure the wind baffles in the side slots.
4. Remove the grate. Take out the fuel tank.
5. Fill the fuel tank. Use only the correct naphtha fuel - "Coleman", "Iosol", etc. labelled for camp stoves. Unscrew filler cap. Pour fuel through filtering funnel into tank keeping it in a level position. Replace cap and tighten securely. Don't remove filler cap while stove is operating.
6. Insert the generator into the large hole in the front of the stove, then into the opening in the mixing chamber. Engage the hanger brackets into slots, taking care that the stove handle is out of the way allowing the tank to fit tightly against the case.
