

3.082 Coleman Stoves -Operation

## TO PUMP UP THE FUEL TANK

- 1. Rotate the pump knob 3 times to the left.
- 2. Place thumb over the small hole in the knob, pull out the plunger and pump it vigorously, about 20 times until it resists.
- 3. Keeping the finger over the hole, push plunger in and rotate pump knob to the right until tight.

## TO LIGHT THE STOVE

- 1. Turn air valve to "up" position.
- 2. Strike match and hold flame over master burner, keeping your hand well to the right.
- 3. Turn on the gas with control knob. Remove match as soon as gas lights. Turn on gas fully, and immediately, turn it down until a "good" flame is burning.
- 4. Flames should turn to a steady blue flame within a minute.
- 5. Turn down air valve 1 minute after lighting. Put on grate.

## **AUXILIARY BURNER**

- 1. To light auxiliary burner, hold a lighted match over burner, pull out valve and turn it away from you.
- 2. To turn it off, turn valve towards you and push in.

If the flame goes down while cooking, you can pump up the gas without turning off the gas.

## TO TURN STOVE OFF

Make sure that the auxiliary burner is turned off.

- 1. Turn up air valve during last minute of burning.
- 2. Turn off main control knob.
- 3. When flame is out, release pressure in fuel tank to avoid leaking. Unscrew filler cap slowly. When pressure is released screw cap tightly.
- 4. Clean stove after each use to avoid flare-ups, clogging of gas line, and easier final clean-up.
