Resources can be looked at from three areas. These are facilities, people, and printed materials. All these can help you in planning and programming your camps. Here are some of the things that you can acquire through other agencies. Some addresses will be included in your handout material, or consult your local telephone directory.

There are a wide variety of facilities available to you. Some will be at low or no cost, others may cost more. Always check fees in advance so that you have a clear understanding of all costs. For instance, some locations will have not only a charge per camper, but also a charge for each vehicle.

Some examples of suitable facilities include:

- ◆ Provincial Parks
- ◆ Military Facilities
- ◆ Church and "Y" camps
- ◆ Ministry of Natural Resources
- ◆ Scout and Guide camps
- ◆ Municipal Parks
- ◆ Conservation Areas
- ◆ Native Reserves
- ◆ Kiwanis, Rotary, & Lions clubs

Always visit a facility prior to booking it, to ensure that it is suitable for your planned activities.
