SUBJECT:

INTERNATIONAL FRIENDSHIP

OBJECTIVE(S)

To have the candidate establish contact with other young people, preferably members of St. John, in other countries (not a relative).

PREREQUISITES

None.

INSTRUCTORS/EVALUATORS

An adult who is familiar with the other country and who has not been involved in the arrangements of this proficiency subject.

REFERENCES AND MATERIALS

Candidates who wish to correspond with a person in another country may:

- 1. Submit, through their officers, the request, giving as many details as possible for a St. John pen friend.

CONTENT

1. Have a regular pen friend in the country of their choice for a period of at least six months, and have corresponded at least six times. If the pen friend is a member of St. John, the correspondence should include a description of St. John activities in that country.

Note: Instructor/Evaluator should see the letters which have been written and should ask the candidate about his or her pen friend and their correspondence (refrain from any personal questions).

- 2. Know, in broad outline, the history, geography, economy and politics of this country and inhabitants.
- 3. Prepare a scrap book or album showing photographs, cut-outs, newspaper clippings, publicity, postage stamps, badges, pins, etc. something of the Canadian environment, its people and their cultures to send to the pen friend.
- 4. Prepare a scrap book or album about the country where the pen friend lives, including things the candidate has received from the pen friend and information gathered by the candidate.

DURATION

Minimum of six months.

CERTIFICATION

To qualify, candidates must show a satisfactory standard of interest and attainment, having regard to their age, in all parts of the contents.
