Applications for this course will be **due by May 15, 2007**. A confirmation letter will be sent to those whose applications are received prior to this date. No extensions or refunds will be granted.

The candidate cost for this course will be \$20.00 for the weekend and will cover course materials, refreshments and snacks will be provided. Transportation, meals and accommodation costs will be the responsibility of the course candidates. However, the Branch has offered the use of the building for anyone who may need overnight stay (floor space available).
