Position Description:

- Responsible for the development and/or implementation of Brigade Youth programs for Youth volunteers and leaders, including programs targeted at recruitment, retention and membership development.
- · Provide direction and support, to Area Cadet Officers in matters related to Brigade Units (with youth) within their respective Areas.
- Responsible for the management and development of Provincial Cadet staff, • including their recruitment, assessment, support and succession planning.
- Coordinate, in conjunction with the Provincial and Area Commissioners, the activities of the Provincial and Area Cadet staff.
- Coordinate provincial Youth programs including, the Ontario portion of the International Cadet First Aid Competition, Camp Accreditation courses, provincial Camps and camping initiatives, etc.
- Assist with the development and implementation of provincial leadership initiatives related to the youth component of the Brigade.

- Assist with the development of the provincial Brigade budget as it relates to Youth and associated initiatives.
- Maintain liaison with the Provincial Brigade Committee (volunteers and staff), and the National Cadet Officer, on matters affecting Youth, including administration, training, and member recognition issues.
- Coordinate the development and distribution of provincial Youth related communications and publications, including the maintenance of the provincial Cadet web site (an information/communication tool for Youth members/leaders across Ontario).
- Coordinate the Provincial/Area Cadet Team (PACT), including their quarterly meetings.
- Promote activities within the Youth programs to ensure the interaction of Brigade members provincially, nationally and internationally.

Other Duties:

- Actively participate as a member of the Provincial Brigade Committee, and ad hoc provincial committees/working groups, as required.
- · Carry out other responsibilities as assigned by the Provincial Commissioner.
